

SAPOTEE SOIL: EMPOWERMENT

ENCOURAGING STUDENTS' VOICES

WE PLANTING SEEDS ON D SAPOTEE SOIL

Set up a box in the library labelled: WE PLANTING SEEDS ON D SAPOTEE SOIL

Invite students to 'plant' (write & drop) their seeds in the box, randomly and anonymously if preferred.

Writings should be a few adjectives or a one-line answer.

Consider the following topics:

October: What big dreams do I have?

November: What makes me 'ME'?

December: How can I be a peace-keeper at home? At school? January: What makes me proud of my community?

February: What has failure taught me?

April: What has experience taught me?

May: How do I stay inspired?

These 'seeds' can then be added to the Sapotee Soil poster and displayed in the Library.
